MINUTES OF COMMITTEE MEETING on 29 August 2016 at 42 Blacket Place

1.MINUTES: Minutes of 16 May 2016 were approved.

2. OUTSTANDING ACTION ITEMS

Mainly cleared, see Closed Actions schedule at end of Minutes.

3. COMMITTEE ARRANGEMENTS

Committee members relection: BC willing to stay on. JK wishes to step down in December. IC to be proposed as Chair and GPCC rep, willing to continue with Newsletter but would prefer to hand over Neighbourhood Watch coordination to one of the local coordinators who would join the Committee. FC noted need to spread responsibilities beyond Chair. There are vacancies for further members on the committee.

Action May16.02: Seek new committee members – roles event coordination, IT, Neighbourhood watch

4.PLANNING

Duncan Street garage (West Blacket): Refused, fresh application submitted. Objection made. **Minto Hotel** (16/17/18 Minto Street): Permission granted. FC noted that the objections coordinated by the Association had resulted in significant improvements to the plans and thanked the Committee for their efforts.

23 East Mayfield: Permission granted.

5.QUIETROUTE 30 CYCLING ROUTE CONSULTATION

The proposed route joins up Holyrood Park with Ratcliffe Terrace via upper Blacket Place, Blacket Avenue and Duncan Street. HD and IC reported on the prestakeholder meeting with CEC and their consultant and representatives of the West Blacket Association held on 17 May. Noted that:

- this was very useful and the CEC and consultant took points on board
- the University have not allowed the route to go through Pollock Halls grounds
- the west end of Blacket Avenue will be one way for traffic other than cycles and lights will be installed at the junction with Minto Street
- there will be a full public consultation, probably in September/October.

The Committee agreed that, while residents are likely to have varying views, the Association will focus on core points including ensuring that access to and from Blacket at both east and west entrances is maintained.

6.GRANGE/PRESTONFIELD COMMUNITY COUNCIL (GPCC)

- Noted Newington Cemetery will be open on Doors Open Day.
- The Committee nominated IC replace HD as the BA's delegate to the GPCC. This was agreed unanimously.

7.NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

IC reported on the South Central Neighbourhood Partnership on 9/8/16:

- Limited police contribution
- Many complaints re erratic refuse collection post CEC reorganisation of collections.

Crime: no major incidents in Blacket but continuing concerns re high level of housebreaking in south Edinburgh. Police Burglary unit reinstated but historic intelligence lost.

8.BLACKET AVENUE WORKING PARTY

- Shrubbery beside Aln Lodge (east end Blacket Avenue): HMcK discussed with Council. Current owner of Aln Lodge is not using the ground so responsibility rests with CEC to maintain fence and shrubbery. Agreed to split fencing cost 50:50 with CEC. HMcK coordinating contractor, awaiting CEC approval.
- Email appeals for help generated 6 volunteers for tree pruning and 1 for shrubbery tidying.
- No major plans for expenditure.

8.TREASURER'S REPORT

- Open Gardens generated £95, much less than previous years (£200-£250). Attributed to lower turnout due to cold damp weather.
- Agreed no immediate requirement to increase subscription from £5 pa.
- Possible move to direct debits discussed. Agreed to investigate process, while immediate focus should be on reducing proportion of "nonpaying" residents who are up to one third of subscribers.
