PLANNING MATTERS

As many of you will be aware, work has been ongoing at 23 Minto Street. The Association was very concerned that the work that was being carried out varied significantly from that detailed in the

plans. Despite repeated communications with the Council Planning Department detailing these discrepancies, we were disappointed to hear that the building had been granted retrospective planning permission on the grounds that the changes were 'not material'. We feel that a dangerous precedent has been set and are working to raise a complaint against the Council and if necessary take the matter to the ombudsman. We will keep you advised on our progress.
